



2012 BASKETBALL GUIDELINES

Regular High School Basketball rules will be used except where special adaptations are noted.

ALL DIVISIONS: Two 14-minute halves. Running clock except for the final 30 seconds of the first half, the final two minutes of the game and during free throws and time-outs. **No pressing with a 15 point lead.**

5th & 6th GRADE DIVISION: ***NO PRESSING*** OR FULL COURT PRESSURE IS ALLOWED IN THIS DIVISION, EXCEPT FOR THE **LAST 2 MINUTES OF THE GAME.**

Each team is allowed **3 time-outs per game.**

First overtime will be two minutes in length. A second overtime if needed will be sudden death (the first team to score wins). **1 time out in overtime.**

Two officials will be provided per game.

Decisions of the tournament directors will be final.

Players: May play in only one division in the tournament. Younger players may participate in an older division. Evidence of proper eligibility is the coach's responsibility.

TEAMS: Each team member must have the same color of top with a number.

Teams will have a roster of at least 6 players and medals are available for a maximum of 12 players. A maximum of two bench coaches will be allowed. Each team is asked to provide a scorekeeper for their team. The SAC will provide an official scorekeeper.

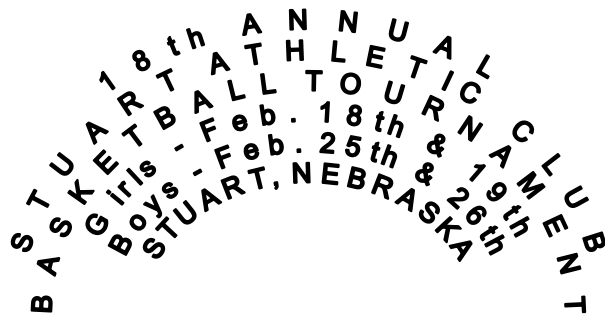
Teams should arrive 15 minutes prior to your game and be ready to play at game time. Each team will provide their own warm-up balls.

Games will be played at the Stuart High School Gym and the Stuart Auditorium. Locker rooms will be provided at the high school gym only.

Each division may consist of 8 teams. A few extra teams will be allowed if time allows.

Final date for entries to be accepted will be February 6, 2012. Entries are limited and will be on a first come basis, so register early. Entry fee of \$50 – (5th & 6th division) and \$60 – (7th & 8th division) will hold tournament spot. Roster with numbers and release of liability forms are needed at least 5 days before tournament starting date.

AWARDS: Individual medals and t-shirts to 1st place team.
Individual medals to 2nd, 3rd, 4th place teams.
